The site of the disused playground could be better used for housing or landscape improvements.

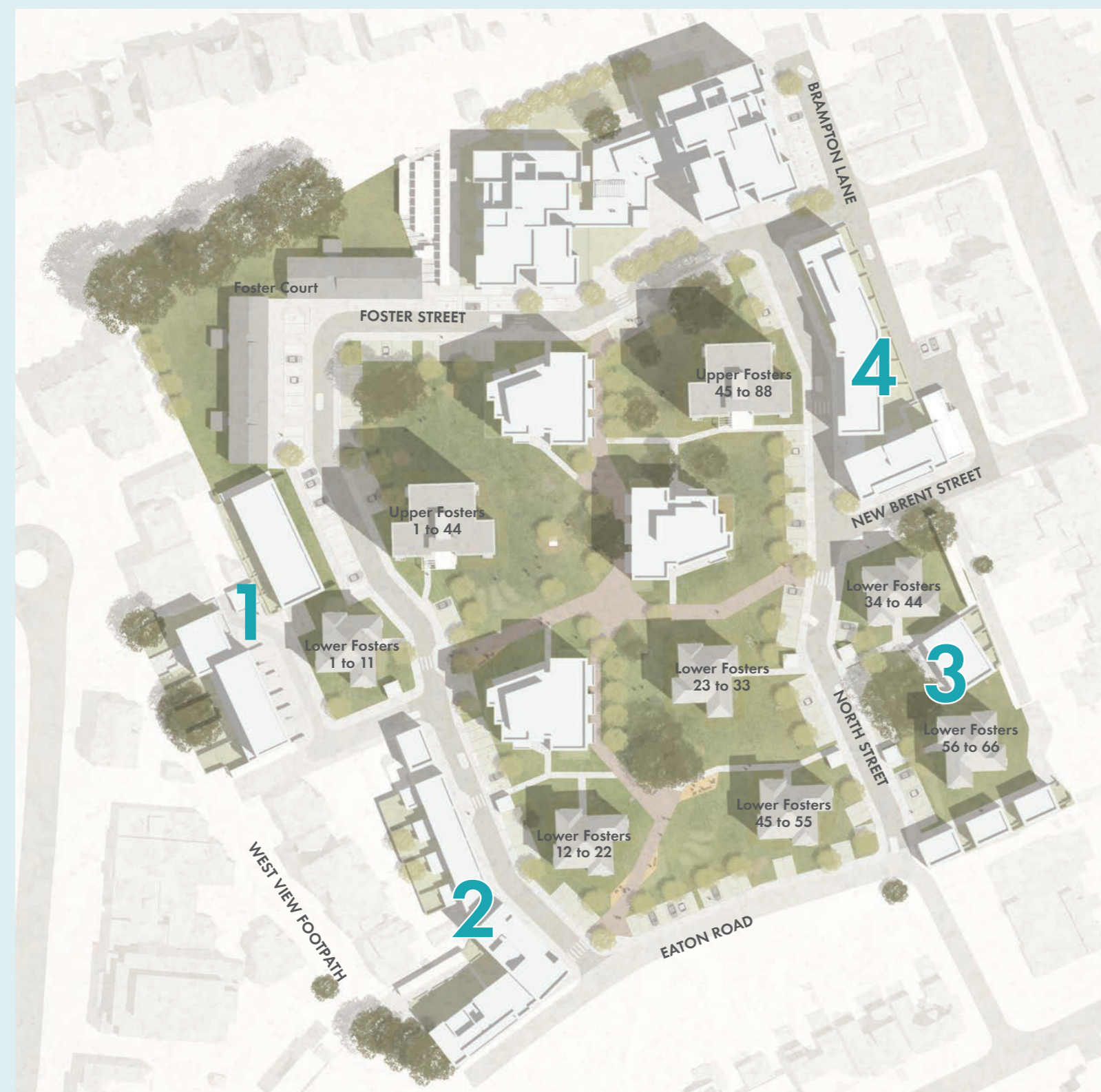
BUILDING NEW HOMES

homes around the edges

Low rise homes around the edge of Fosters Estate will play an important role in improving the estate through creating a continuous 'front' onto the central green and replacing neglected areas with new homes.

Two, three and four-storey buildings around the edges will face inwards onto the new street and towards the green space at the heart of Fosters Estate.

The edges of the estate will change from the untidy backs of shops, garages and unsupervised corners which attract antisocial behaviour, to pleasant homes along a tree-lined street.
