# Barnet Council – Caring for people, our places and the planet

We have a new mission at Barnet Council: to care for people, our places and the planet. Here's a flavour of what we are doing:



### **Caring for** people

- We've launched our child participation and family involvement strategy called 'My Say Matters.' By involving children, young people and their families in the way we shape and develop our services we ensure their voices are heard.
- We're enabling more discharges from **hospital** through social care than ever before.
- We've launched a new £2m residents' **support fund** to help people struggling with the cost-of-living crisis, taking our total support to over £9m.



· Working with local businesses and not for profit groups, we're launching warm spaces for residents to visit this winter.



- A **£240k** community innovation fund is now available to community groups to support the cost of living crisis.
- 1,000s of residents enjoyed our biggest-ever **Black History Month**, bringing together the borough's communities to celebrate with over 70 events.
- We're offering **small grants** to community groups to encourage a Winter of Festivals.
- · We've launched an engagement and **co-production** strategy to involve residents even more in shaping our adult social care services.



#### **Caring for** our places

- 2 community safety hubs have opened in Edaware and West Hendon, with more due to open soon, so residents can easily raise concerns about crime with police and council enforcement
- We've launched **safer streets ward walks** aimed at addressing place-based issues to help everyone to feel safe.
- Our new **community skips service** will visit **74** neighbourhoods around the borough throughout the year.
- We're investing **£500k more** to 'deep clean' our streets.



- We're providing £250k more to repair potholes and pavements.
- Our fly-tipping campaign lets residents know how to report issues and warns offenders against fly-tipping.







- We've started work to deliver **1.000** new council homes at 50% of market rental rates.
- Sheffield Hallam University will open a **campus** for up to **5,000 students** at Brent Cross Town in 2025/26, strengthening the educational offer to local people.
- We're working with TfL and GLA to secure government Levelling Up funding for a redeveloped, step-free tube station at Colindale.



## **Caring for** the planet



- We've declared a climate emergency and pledged to be a **net zero council by 2030** and a net zero borough by 2042.
- Our Climate Change Citizens' Assembly launches in January with 40 residents looking at how we can get to Net Zero.



- We're installing **510** more electric vehicle charging points across the borough.
- We joined the Mayor of London's anti-idling campaign to improve the air we breathe.



• As part of the council's Brent Cross Cricklewood regeneration scheme, the **£8bn** Brent Cross Town development will have an on-site energy centre and the largest air source heat pump installation in Europe. It will provide **low carbon heating** to the planned 6,700 new homes and all energy supplied will come from 100% renewal sources. The new Brent Cross West railway station is also under construction.





#### An engaged and effective council

• Our new **corporate plan** will put caring for people, our places and the planet at the heart of everything we do.



- We're involving communities more closely in shaping our services and local areas. We've set out how in our new **community engagement** and participation strategy.
- We have been recognised as working to become a dementia friendly borough by the Alzheimer's Society and have over **10.000** residents and staff trained as Dementia Friends.



- A new **call-back option** added to our phone service and British Sian Language and **ReciteMe** tools in our on-line service will make it easier for people to contact us.
- We are moving to a Cabinet system of governance and are making the system more open and accountable.
