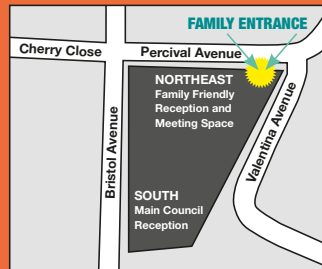

# We can help you get back on track

And we know, that you know yourself best

## Things an Engage worker could support you with:

- Help to feel safe in the local community
- Education, employment, and apprenticeships
- Engaging in a positive activities such as sports and music
- Worries about drugs or alcohol
- Knowing your rights
- Worries or concerns around health and wellbeing

Getting arrested and being held in a custody cell can be **STRESSFUL**, **SCARY**, and **confusing**. But it can also be your key moment for change. If you choose to, an Engage youth worker can guide you through the process of getting your life back on track.

You will get a dedicated youth worker who will help you to achieve your personal goals. We believe that you know your situation best. So our job is to hear you out, and together come up with

## a plan that works for you.

## How does it all work?



**STEP 1**

An Engage Youth worker will visit you while you're in custody

**STEP 2**

Your Engage worker will arrange a place and time to meet with you on 3 sessions outside of custody to work on a personalised plan.



**STEP 3**

With support from your Engage worker you'll be able to put your plan into action.



**STEP 4**

With your Engage worker you'll review your progress and decide the next steps. This includes talking about other services that can help support you.
