Project update

We would like to thank all residents impacted by these works for your continued patience and cooperation whilst we reconstruct Hampden Way. Furthermore, to those residents within the Phase Two work zone for ensuring your vehicles were moved on time.

Despite heavy rainfall in September, the project is still on track. Phase Two is scheduled for completion on 8 November 2024. You can find details on Phase Three on the back page of this newsletter.

We aim to reopen the road for Christmas on 9 December 2024. Work will re-commence as scheduled in January 2025 with Phase 4.

Wedding on Hampden Way

The phasing plan would have seen the road closed and the bride-to-be unable to safely access the bridal carriage in her wedding dress. Concerned this would affect the brides departure from the family home to the church, mother-of-the-bride Christalla made contact with the Community Engagement Manager to request help.

Following discussions, Ray tweaked the phasing plan to ensure the bridal carriage access to the Lambrou's home.




Phase Three

Phase Three of the resurfacing works will start on 9 November 2024, and is scheduled to be completed on 9 December 2024. Phase Three is between Hampden Square to 2 Hampden Way.

Walkways either side of the works will be available, providing access to local businesses. Further to this:

- Osidge Lane Pub will be accessible via the pub entrance.
- Southgate Motor Engineering will be accessible from the side roads leading up to Hampden Way.
- Hampden Way Nursery will be accessible via the footpath. The newly resurfaced road will also be open for vehicle drop off / pick up.



We kindly ask that residents and businesses remove all vehicles parked from Osidge Lane Pub to the alleyway leading up to The Woodlands before the start date of Phase Three. You will be unable to move your vehicle once excavation has commenced. There are no parking restrictions in the surrounding roads.
