Project update

We would like to thank all residents impacted by these works for your continued patience and cooperation whilst we reconstruct Hampden Way.

Phase 3 is now complete and Hampden Way has been reopened for the Christmas period. TfL have also confirmed the bus route will be re-instated during the period.

In the first 3 phases, we have successful reconstructed the road from Hampden Square (starting outside Osidge Arms) through to 77 Hampden Way. We have completed up to 9000 onsite hours and the project is still on time, despite seeing 11 days of extreme weather.

We have two phases of reconstruction to be completed in the New Year and are on course to complete the full reconstruction of Hampden Way by the end of March, 2025.

Phase 4 will commence in January 2025 and further details are on the back of this newsletter.








Phase four

Phase 4 of the resurfacing works will start on 7 January 2025, and is scheduled to be completed on 1 of March 2025, weather depending. These works will run from 72 to 121 Hampden Way, and take up to 8 weeks to complete. This section of the road will be closed for the duration of this phase.



We kindly ask that all those who live between Chase Way and Arlington Road to move their vehicles before the start date of Phase 4. **You will be unable to move your vehicle once excavation has commenced.** There are no parking restrictions in the surrounding roads.
