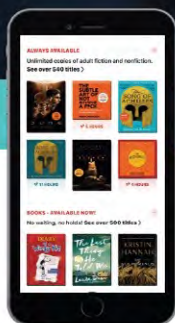

Welcome to the special summer edition of our Creative Communities programme.

This summer, there are plenty of exciting events for all ages, including the Barnet Summer Read, the PAWsome Barnet Book Detectives! Sign-up from Saturday 5 July. There's a fantastic programme of events throughout the school holidays to keep children entertained all summer long too.

Tickets and Booking

Some of our events require a small charge. This allows us to continue to provide a range of events and activities. We particularly welcome those living with dementia and their carers to our Loving Life activities. Loving Life is supported using public funding by the National Lottery through Arts Council England.

Found Word-Story Postcards

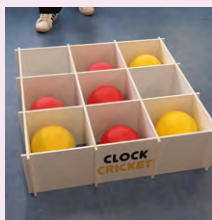

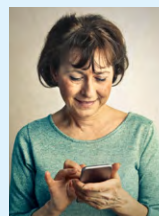

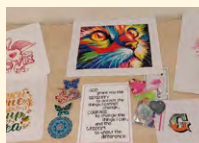
