I write to comment on my great worry regarding the Edgware Policy in the proposed Main Modifications to the Barnet Local Plan. This is really a great concern to me having lived here for some time now and seeing the changes that have taken place during that time. Edgware has changed dramatically and if these plans go ahead will change even more radically which quite frankly disturbs my well being. Already the population has grown and the building of homes both for private and rental purposes have increased without the necessary infrastructure to adequately service the amount of people inhabiting the area. Should the plans apparently in place for the development go ahead I dread to think what a complete and utter mess this area would become. People would be massing in an area not fit for either residential or commercial purposes and the streets and walkways would become unfit for the public to live their lives.
